## National Park Passes

The price for a National Park senior pass will increase from **\$10.00 to \$80.00 on August 28, 2017**. This pass is available to US citizens or permanent residents aged 62 or better.

### Pass benefits are:

Traveling companions can also enter for free. The Senior Passes admit pass owner/s and passengers in a noncommercial vehicle at per-vehicle fee areas and pass owner plus three adults, not to exceed four adults, where per-person fees are charged. (Children under 16 are always admitted free).

Also, at many sites, the Senior Passes provide the pass owner (only) a discount on Expanded Amenity Fees (such as camping, swimming, boat launching, and guided tours).

The pass is a lifetime pass for qualifying applicants.

National Park passes online for seniors are \$10.00 plus a \$10.00 handling fee before August 28th.

Passes can also be purchased at National Parks such as the Cabrillo National Monument in San Diego. See link above for a complete listing.

The passes cover entrance and standard amenity (day use) recreation fees and provide discounts on some expanded amenity recreation fees.
