We plan weddings, birthday parties and family reunions with enthusiasm. That same enthusiasm may not be present when its time to develop an emergency plan—one which could save lives. Unexpected events can be easily resolved if you have a plan. In the case of a power outage, call your local power company

using a cell phone for the special recorded message for residents. Know where to find your flashlight with working batteries (a cell phone light will suffice). Turn off your computer and lights but leave one on to signal when the power is restored. Do not light candles, gas stove burners or open your refrigerator door. Try to rest or sleep.

In a serious, widespread emergency, turn on your battery-operated radio for directions to either evacuate or stay inside. Proceed as directed at the first announcement. If your family includes a dog or cat—make sure their collar and tags provide your phone number. This information will assist neighbors in reuniting you and your pet, should you become separated (a microchip can only be read in a vet's office). Worry and uncertainty will be reduced if one family member (preferably out of your area) is designated as the “call center” to collect family information. More questions? “Do you play Bridge?” If you have been a Village member or volunteer for more than 2 or 3 days, you have probably been asked that question at least once. Dorothy Bickner is the enthusiastic host of the monthly Village Bridge game and she is always looking for new additions to the group. But just who is this Dorothy Bickner . . .

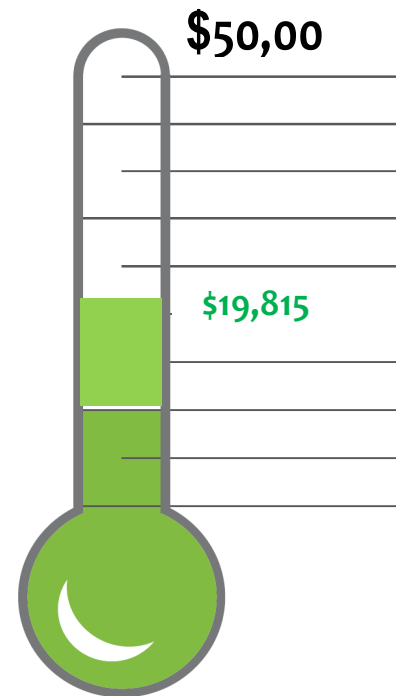
